## Good Sportsmanship and Code of Conduct and Ethics

The Toronto Ultimate Club would like to remind all participants of our TUC policies, specifically our Code of Conduct (Juniors and Adults), and Concussion Policies. We would also like to remind everyone, that the "Prime Time Masters HAT Tournament" event is a tournament for FUN, so please enjoy the event and play with SPIRIT. We wish you all the best, and hope you enjoy what will hopefully be one of the highlights of the ultimate playing season.

The event will be held at Greenwood Park on the Soccer Field (150 Greenwood Avenue, Toronto, ON).
Below is the format and game schedule!
Adult Masters Division

- Total Entries: 4 teams
- Group/Pool A: Blue, Red, Black, White
- Format:
- The games will be 6v6.
- Gender Ratio: Modified Rule A with World Games Pulling (alternating 40:2F/3O:3F).
- Format will be a round robin of 3 games per team, followed by a final and third place game.
- All games are 60 minutes in length and or a score cap of 13 . Halftime will be at 7 points or 30 minutes.



## Field Map

Greenwood Park - Soccer Field
150 Greenwood Avenue, Toronto, ON
TC - Tournament Control. Please report all scores here!

Field 1 - the most westerly field.
Field 2 - the most easterly field (beside Field 2).
Toilets/Washrooms - public washrooms are in the pavilion that northeast of the soccer field.

Parking - Parking is available on the streets surrounding the Park.

Water - Water will be available onsite via water cooler water bottles. Please bring a full water bottle in the morning.

Food - Please bring your own snacks. Pizza will be available at Tournament Control between 4:30 and 5:30pm.


## Equipment / Team Jerseys (Colour)

For the tournament, team colours have been assigned. We'll ask everyone on red and blue to bring their team colour (or a dark), as well as a white/light shirt.

Tournament Rules
Game Timing - Whistle/horn will be used to keep time throughout the day. One blast will denote the official start of the game slot. Two blasts will signal the end of the time slot which is a hard cap! At hard cap - finish the point. IF the game is tied, play a universe point.

Game Length - All games will be 60 minutes in length! Score cap at 13. Halftime at 7 points or 30 minutes. The halftime time-cap occurs once 30 minutes of play has elapsed. At the halftime cap, play continues until the current scoring attempt is completed. If, after the current scoring attempt is completed, the halftime target has not yet been reached by one time, one is added to the higher score and the resulting number is the new halftime target.

Ties - If the game is tied when the whistle/horn blows, finish the point. If the game is tied and a point is not currently being played when the whistle/horn blows, play a universe point!

Timeouts - There will be two 60 second timeouts per team per game. No timeouts allowed in the last 5 minutes of the game.

Gender Ratio - Based on registrations, we will be using Modified Rule A with World Games Pulling (alternating between 40:2F/ 30:3F). At the start of the game, after the first disc flip, an additional disc flip happens with the winner selecting the gender ration for the first point (in our case, it will be either 4 Open: 2 Female Identifying or 3 Open: 3 Female Identifying). For the second and third points the ratio must be the reverse of the first point. For the fourth and fifth points the ratio must be the same as the first point. This pattern of alternating the ratio every two points repeats until the end of the game (halftime has no impact on the pattern). When there are 3 Female Identifying athletes on the field, a Female Identifying athlete must pull.

Foot blocks - Foot blocks are not allowed except with the explicit prior agreement of both team captains. Any foot block attempted or successful should be treated as a foul.

Rules - Other than the rules listed above, all games will follow TUC's outdoor rules and the USAU 2022-2023 edition rules.

## Seeding and Tiebreaker

When determining seeding of the teams will be selected on the following criteria:

- Win-loss record. If still tied, then,
- Head-to-head record. If still tied, then,
- Goal differential (i.e., plus-minus). Please note the maximum plus-minus for any game will be $+7 /-7$.


## Scorekeeping and Score Reporting

TUC will provide score board at each field.

All teams are asked to nominate a score keeper to keep track of the score throughout the game.
Both teams after the game should/need to report the score to Tournament Control.

## First Aid/Physio

Physio will not be available on-site during this tournament. TUC staff will have a First Aid Kit available for minor injuries.

## Toilets and Changing Rooms

Both male and female toilets/washrooms will be available at the venue, at the pavilion that is northeast of the field (next to the northmost baseball diamond).

## Tournament Control

Tournament Control will be located beside Field 1.
