



## 2026 TUC Beach Fest: Tournament Pack

### Good Sportsmanship and Code of Conduct, and Ethics

The Toronto Ultimate Club would like to remind all participants of our TUC policies, specifically our Code of Conduct (for both [Juniors](#) and [Adults](#)) and [Concussion](#) Policy Suite. We would also like to remind everyone that the TUC Beach Fest event is a tournament for FUN, so please enjoy the event and play with SPIRIT. We wish you all the best and hope you enjoy what will hopefully be one of the highlights of the ultimate playing season.

### Schedule

The event will be held at Woodbine Beach, located at Woodbine Beach Loop, 1675 Lake Shore Blvd E, Toronto, ON M4L 3W6.

Below is the format followed by the game schedule.

- Total Teams: 10
- Format and Gender Ratio:
  - The games will be 5v5 mixed gender
  - Gender Ratio: We will follow Gender Ratio Rule A (3:2, 2:3, 2:3, 3:2, 3:2, etc).
    - Note: At the start of the game, an additional disc flip happens, with the winner selecting the gender ratio for the first point. For the second and third points, the ratio must be the reverse of the first point. For the fourth and fifth points, the ratio must be the same as on the first point. This pattern of alternating the ratio every two points repeats until the end of the game (half-time has NO impact on the pattern).
  - Format will be pool play where each team will get 4 games, followed by finals and placement games.

## Field Map

Woodbine Beach

1675 Lake Shore Blvd E, Toronto, Ontario, M4L 3W6

**TC** – Tournament Control. Please report all scores here!

**Field 1** – the most westerly field.

**Field 2** – the first field to the east of Field 1 that runs North-South

**Field 3** – the second field to the east of Field 1 that runs East-West and is closest to the Boardwalk.

**Field 4** – the second field to the east of Field 1 that runs East-West and is closest to the lake.

**Toilets/Washrooms** – Public washrooms are located to the west of Tournament Control, and East of Field 3 and Field 4.

**Parking** – Please use the Green P lots at Woodbine Beach and Ashbridge's Bay. There is also street parking available north of Lake Shore Blvd.

**Water** – Water will be available on-site via water coolers and water jugs. Please bring a full water bottle in the morning.

**Food** – Please bring your own snacks and/or lunch for fueling between games. We will have some field snacks onsite. There are also several food trucks onsite at Woodbine Beach.

**Physio/First Aid** – LiveActive will be on-site for the duration of the tournament to provide First Aid and support with taping, massage for cramping, etc.





## Tournament Rules

**Game Timing** – A whistle will be used to keep time throughout the day. One blast will signal the official start of the game slot. Two blasts will signal the end of the time slot.

**Game Length** – All games will be 40 minutes in length!

**Ties** – If the game is tied when the whistle blows, finish the point. If the game is tied and a point is not currently being played when the whistle blows, play a universe point!

**Timeouts** – Each team will have one 60-second timeout per game. No timeouts allowed in the last 5 minutes of the game.

**Gender Ratio** – We will follow Gender Ratio Rule A (3:2, 2:3, 2:3, 3:2, 3:2, etc). At the start of the game, an additional disc flip happens, with the winner selecting the gender ratio for the first point. For the second and third points, the ratio must be the reverse of the first point. For the fourth and fifth points, the ratio must be the same as on the first point. This pattern of alternating the ratio every two points repeats until the end of the game (half-time has NO impact on the pattern).

**Rules** – In addition to the rules listed above, all games will follow the [BULA/WFDF Beach Rules](#).

## Seeding and Tiebreaker

When determining seeding of the teams for the next stage of the tournament, the team that advances will be selected on the following criteria:

- Win-loss record. If still tied, then,
- Head-to-head record. If still tied, then,
- Goal differential (i.e. total plus-minus). Please note that the maximum plus-minus for any game will be +11/-11. If still tied, then,
- One throw closest to the target!

## Scorekeeping and Score Reporting

TUC will provide a scoreboard at each field.

All teams are asked to nominate a scorekeeper to keep track of the score throughout the game.

Both teams should report the score to Tournament Control after the game.



## First Aid/Physio

Physio services provided by LiveActive will be available on-site during this tournament. They will support with First Aid, as well as with taping, massage for cramping, etc.

## Toilets and Changing Rooms

Both male and female toilets/washrooms will be available at the venue, located west of Tournament Control and East of Field 3 and Field 4.

## Bad Weather and TUC's Bad Weather Policy

At present, we are expecting rain showers on Sunday. In the event of thunderstorms, TUC will follow the Thunder/Lightning Policy within TUC's [Bad Weather Policy](#).

## TUC's Refund Policy

In the event of a cancellation (rain, field conditions, etc.), TUC will issue refunds in accordance with TUC's [Refund Policy](#). We hope this doesn't happen, but sometimes the weather doesn't cooperate.
